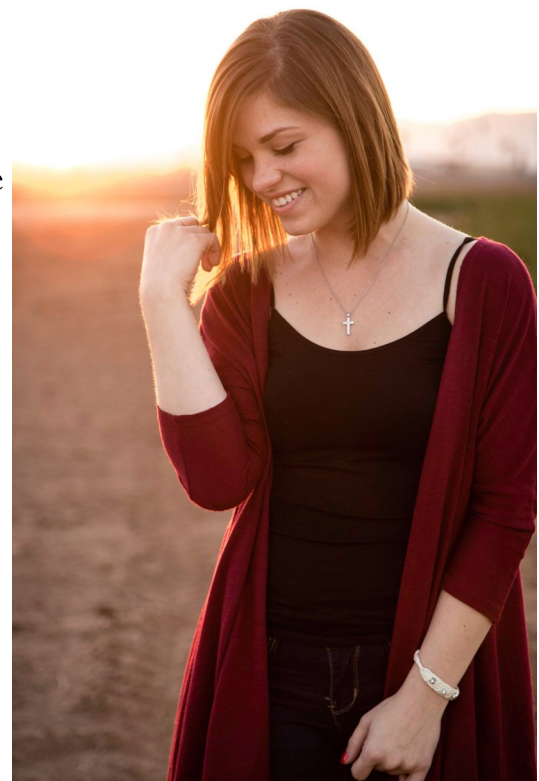
You're 18...Now what?
